A. ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen, living in Oklahoma or from Oklahoma.
- 2. Applicant must be a woman veteran, active duty, Reserve or Guard; or a child or grandchild of a woman veteran, either by blood, legal adoption or stepchild.
- 3. Applicant must have a High School diploma (graduating before the deadline) or General Educational Development (GED) Certificate.
- 4. Applicant must show proof of acceptance to a specific program (degree, certificate, etc.) at an accredited institution, technology center, or training institution.
- 5. Enrollment must be for at least **full time** (12 hours or more) or part time (at least 6 hours) for each enrollment session.
- 6. Prerequisite course work, training experiences and regular course work must be towards a specific degree or program.
- 7. Dropped course work below the institution full time requirement or complete withdrawal from session will constitute reimbursement of scholarship funds, unless mitigating reasons are given in writing to the Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization that show applicant's actions were due to circumstances beyond their control.
- 8. Must have a GPA 3.0 based on a 4.0 scale.
- 9. Other tuition/fees, assistance funds or other scholarships will not disqualify the recipient from use of these scholarship funds.

B. SCHOLARSHIP USES & DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS:

- 1. Full-time recipients (12 hours or more) will be awarded a onetime payment of \$1000.00, and part-time recipients (6-11 hours) will be awarded a onetime payment of \$500.00 on or before the 1st of September for the year of entrance in a qualified program.
- 2. Award can be used for tuition, student fees, books, materials, supplies, equipment, or necessary uniforms.
- 3. Award can be used for all time periods-semesters, trimesters, training time period, etc. (whichever is more advantageous to the applicant).

C. <u>APPLICANT MUST SUBMIT A COMPLETE APPLICATION WITH THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:</u> (Incomplete applications will not be considered.)

- 1. Submission date 1 Mar through 30 Jun.
- 2. Completed scholarship application form.
- Copy of DD214 with any DD215's (discharge/separation papers), or proof of service (i.e. current pay statement). Redact SSN and other classified information, please, prior to submission. In the case of children or grandchildren, a copy of the woman veteran's proof of service is required.
- 4. Copy of picture ID card.
- 5. Copy of one of the following as applicable: latest high school transcript, GED, latest college transcript, or vocational training paperwork.
- 6. Essay (see sect III, page 3).
- 7. Proof of enrollment for upcoming semester, i.e., class schedule, letter from institution.
